

ABSTRACT

Unloyalty refers to the quality of being disloyal. Unloyalty comes from the feeling of a person who can not seem to enjoy what he/she has deserved. This act can come out from many factors. Factor is a circumstance, fact, or influence that contributes to a result. Factor here can refer to many things. It can be concluded that factor is an important role in doing something. Many people do not consider the factors and the aftereffects of being unloyal. In some cases, even people do not realize that they are experiencing the unloyalty itself.
