Review # 1**Recommendation:**

Accept paper conditionally with major revision

Comments:

The authors have deployed a good effort to present a topic that is not frequently tackled in Industrial Engineering. They presented a case study conducted in an organization of higher education using communication audit method.

The literature seems a bit limited and dated. The results are many and presented in 13 tables. However, it would be beneficial to provide more explanations and validation.

The conclusion does not identify the benefits of this study and what would be the opportunities for future planning and recommendation.

The paper needs a thorough review and proofreading to address the many typos and sentence structure issues.

Review # 2

Recommendation:

Accept paper conditionally with minor revision

Comments:

The paper contributes well towards identifying employee's behavior using the communication audit as a tool. The title and quality of the paper are good. conclusion and summary bring the main points of the research. However, the result section needs to be more organized, tables need to be fixed and the English language needs to be revised and a thorough proofread is required.
