- Dalam penggunaan sitasi/kutipan “harus disebutkan sumbernya dalam **DAFTAR PUSTAKA**”
- **Tujuan :**
 - > menghargai ide orang lain
 - > menghindari plagiasi
 - > membantu pembaca menggunakan sumber primer

Pentingnya Penulisan Sitiran

- Mempermudah pembaca dan penulis melakukan penelusuran terhadap sumber aslinya
- Pengembangan ilmu pengetahuan melalui tulisan yang saling terkait (*state of the art*)
- Mencegah tindakan plagiat

Penulisan Sitasi dalam Teks

1. **PARENTETIK** - kutipan ditulis secara langsung dengan tanda kurung berisikan nama penulis, tahun terbit serta halaman
2. **CATATAN KUTIPAN** – menampilkan sumber sitasi pada catatan kaki footnote
3. **SITASI NUMERIK** – menampilkan urutan digunakannya sumber kutipan dengan angka di akhir teks

Penulisan Kutipan

1. **LANGSUNG** – dengan tanda kutip (“...”), pendek maksimal 40 kata atau lebih dari 4 baris dan jika panjang dengan menjorok kedalam teks dengan spasi 1
2. **TIDAK LANGSUNG** – paraphrase dan ringkasan

Permasalahan Umum

- 1. Tidak menggunakan sumber primer (Jurnal/Conference)**
- 2. Pustaka yang digunakan tidak mutakhir/ tahun lama**
- 3. Penulisan kutipan yang salah, tidak konsisten mengikuti salah satu gaya (style)**
- 4. Penulisan daftar pustaka yang salah, tidak konsisten mengikuti salah satu gaya (style)**

MENGAPA MENGGUNAKAN REFERENCE MANAGER

dapat terhindar dari plagiat. Berikut ini beberapa hal yang penting dilakukan ketika menyiapkan naskah untuk diterbitkan.

1. Mencari jurnal yang akan dituju untuk penulisan, kemudian mencari gaya selingkung atau petunjuk penulisan (*author guideline*) dan kalau bisa memperoleh templat penulisan sehingga memudahkan penulisan naskah.
2. Menelusur literatur ke beberapa pangkalan data (*database*) terkemuka agar dapat dibuat perkembangan penelitian yang dilakukan (*state of the art*), dan penelitian yang dihasilkan memiliki kebaruan (*novelty*).
3. Membuat catatan detail terkait dengan sumber yang akan kita gunakan dalam penulisan, terkait dengan siapa penulisnya, kapan diterbitkan, dan di mana diterbitkan. Hal ini sepatutnya dilakukan di awal penelitian sewaktu menyusun proposal penelitian, bukan di akhir ketika menyiapkan naskah publikasi.
4. Menggunakan gaya penulisan dan referensi standar sesuai dengan yang diminta seperti Harvard, Chicago, atau Turabian; jangan pernah mencampur adukan gaya penulisan.
5. Menggunakan aplikasi referensi dalam pengutipan dan pembuatan daftar referensi atau bibliografi seperti Mendeley, Zotero, Refwork, atau Endnote.
6. Membuat pernyataan jelas jika akan menyalin langsung, mengutip (*pharaprasing*) atau meringkas (*summarizing*).
7. Jangan pernah mengutip referensi yang tidak jelas atau tidak lengkap sumbernya sebaik apapun isinya



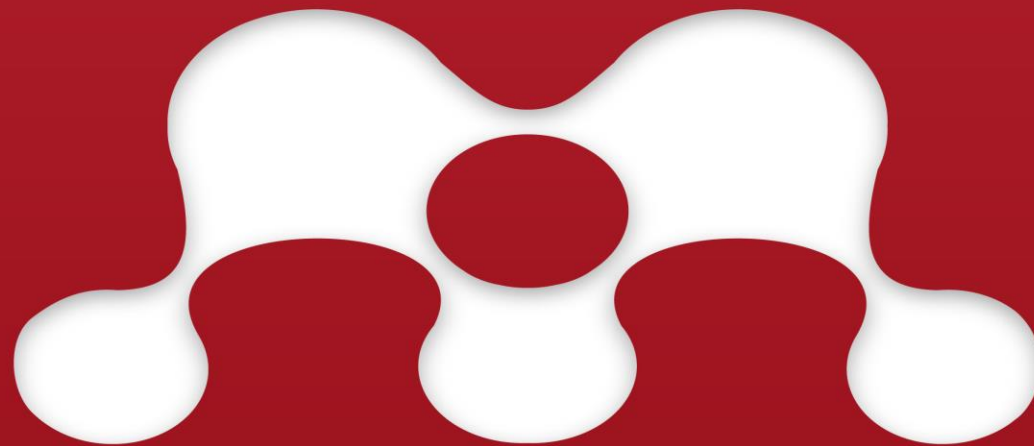

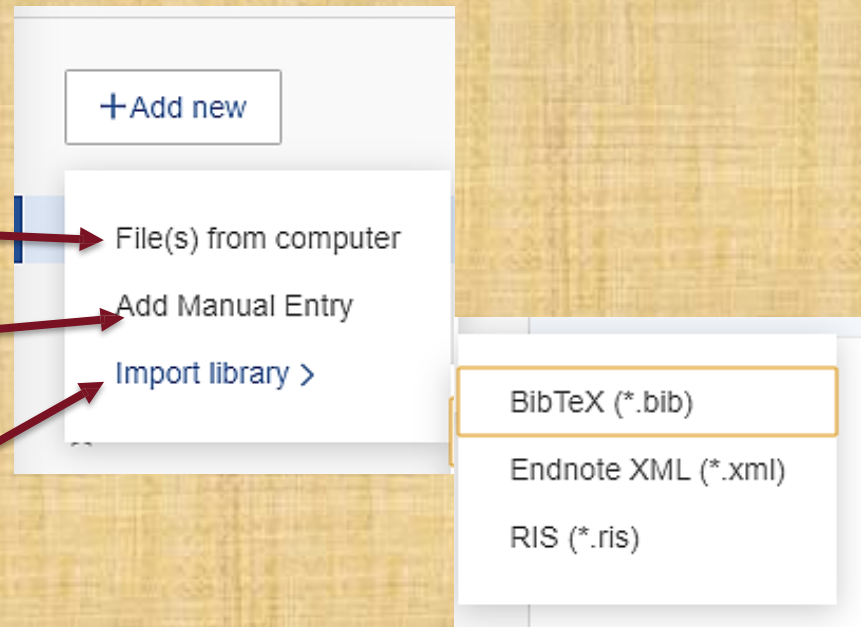

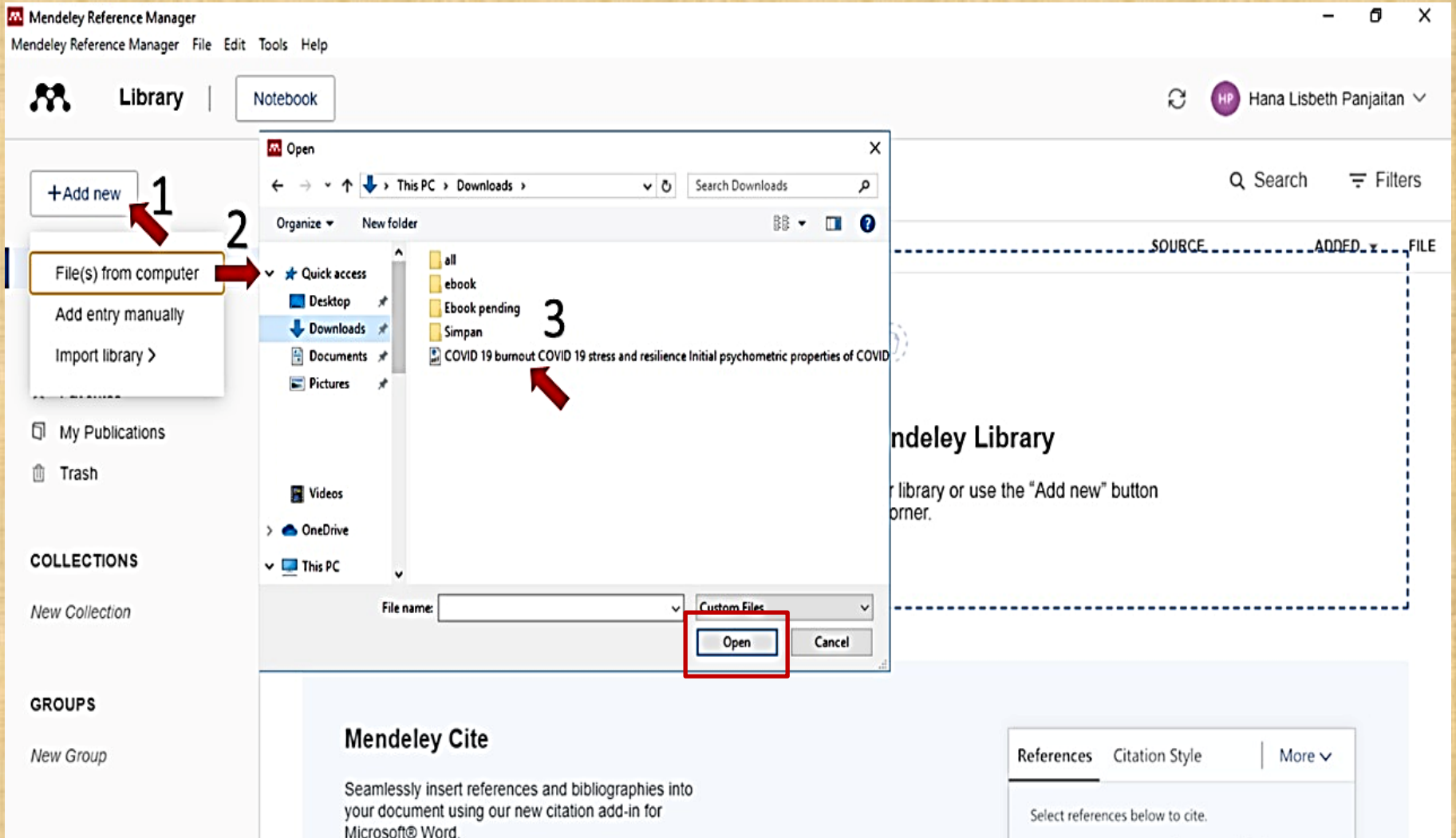
This study validated a 10-item COVID-19 Burnout Scale (COVID-19-BS) to measure burnout associated with COVID-19. Participants were 402 Turkish adults (76.4% female; Meanage = 27.37 ± 8.90). Factor analytic approach yielded a one-factor solution, with high internal consistency reliability. Mediation analysis showed that COVID-19 stress predicted resilience and COVID-19 burnout. 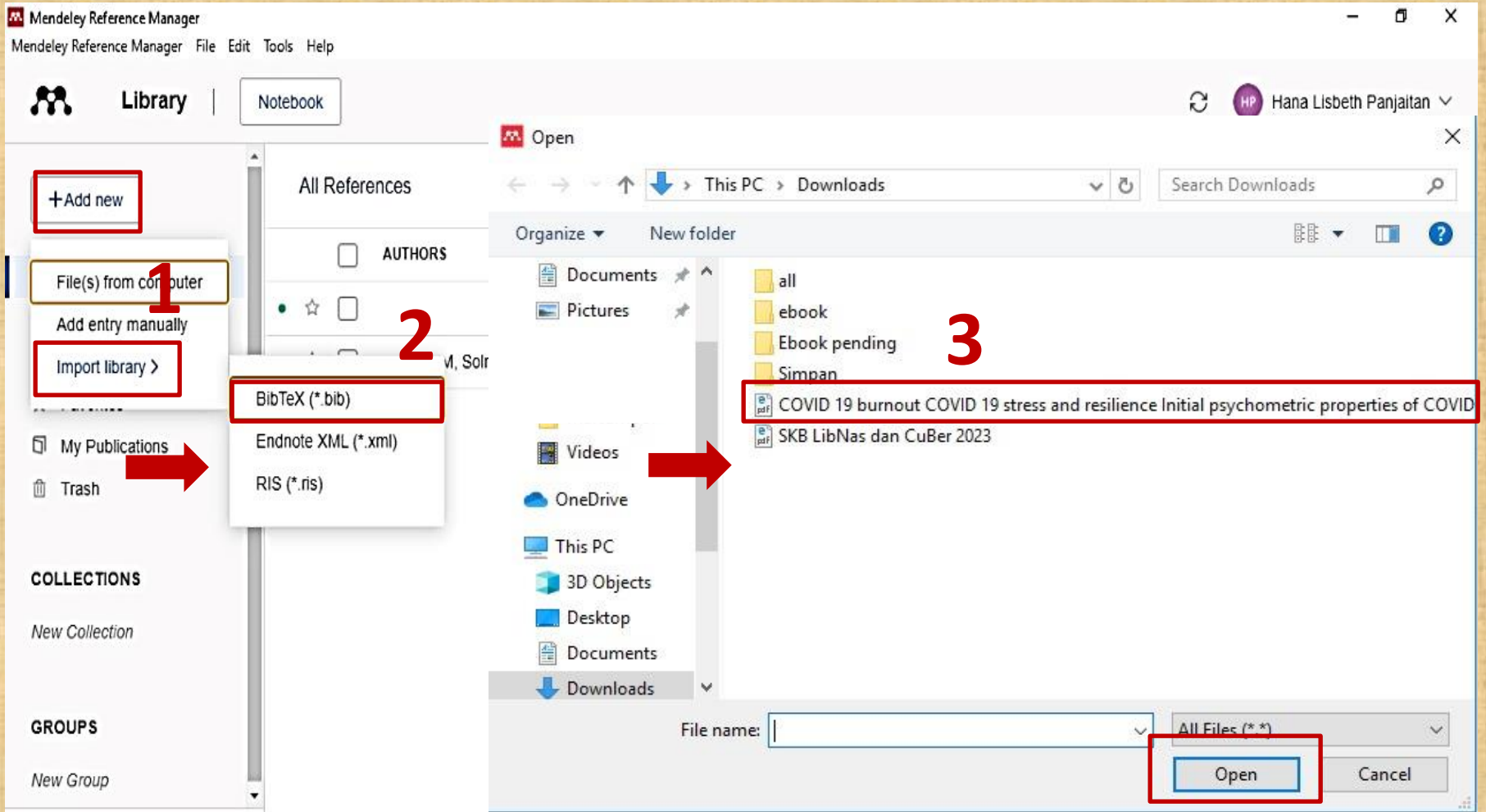
