 (7) A : “Mangkane,aku bingung iki. Gawe’ no po’o PR iki.”

 (3) A : “La lapo bimbel?”
 (4) B : “**Jangkrik!** Ngomongo ae koen lek ape ngenyek aku!”
 (5) A : “He... he... ulanganmu elek maneh iyo to?”
 (6) B : “Iyo, X **gatheli** iku mosok ngek? I aku soal ulangan sing angel-angel.”
 (7) C : “He, lapo, **cuk**? Ngono yo, kumpul-kumpul ga ngajak-ngajak aku.”
 (8) B : “Opone sing kumpul-kumpul iku?”
