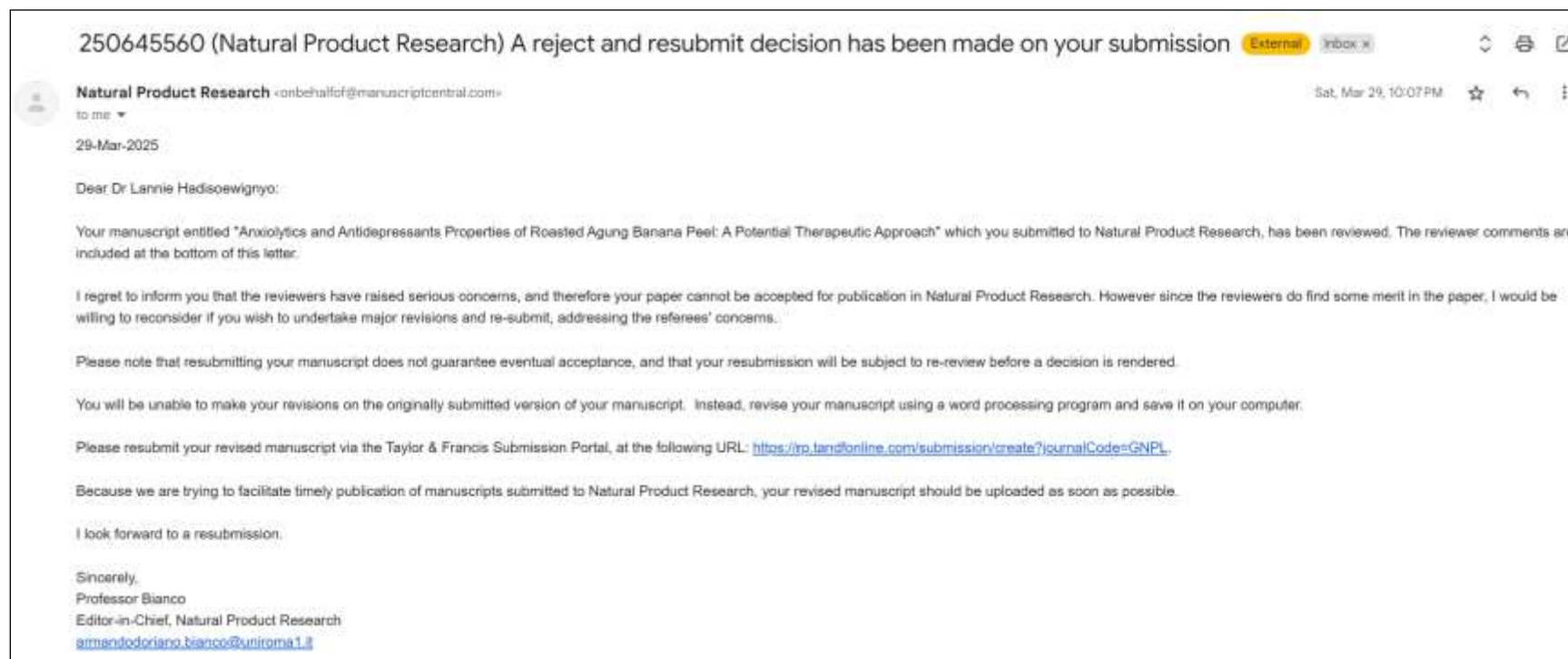

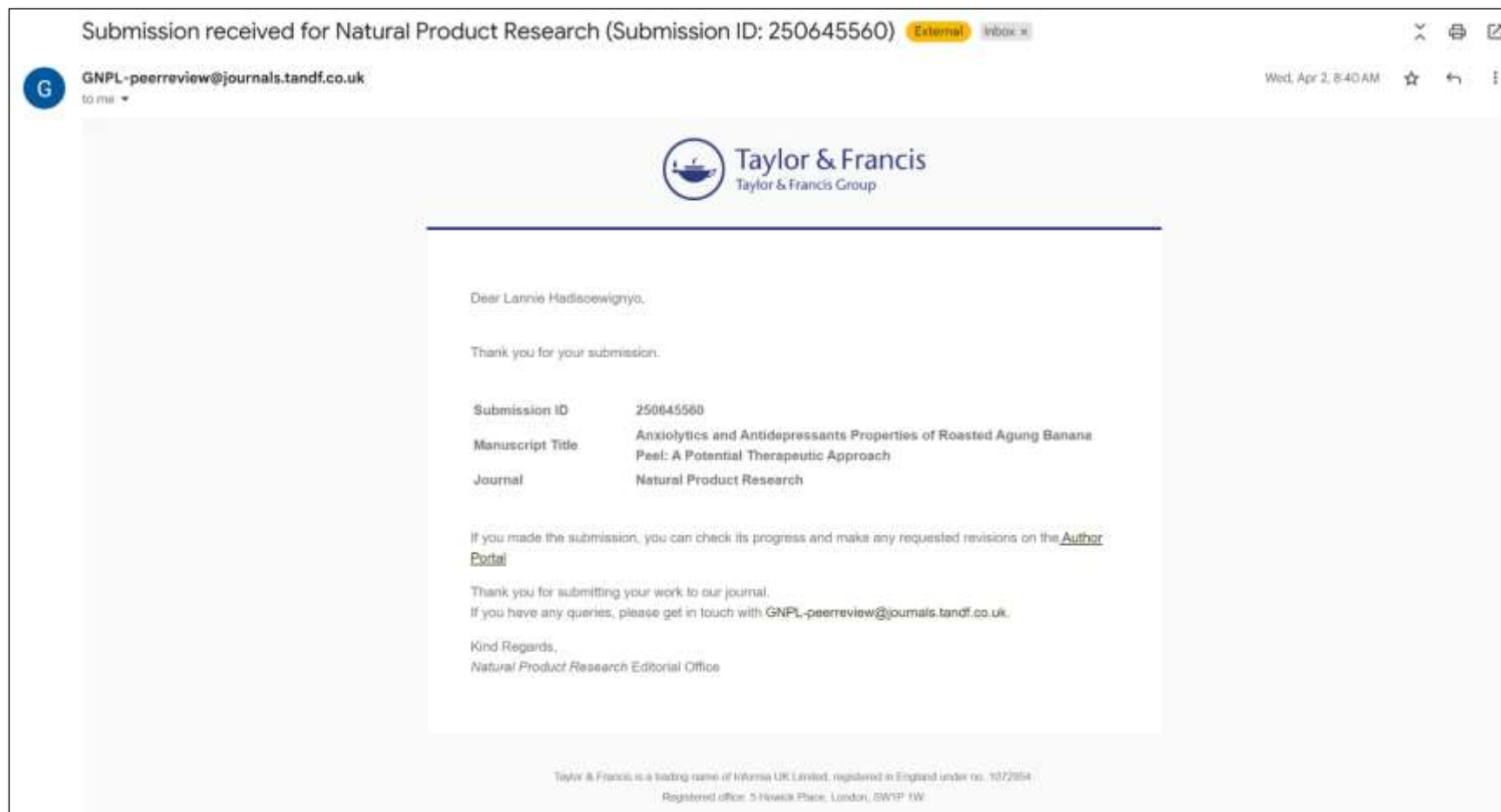

Tab S1: The authors should carefully check the separation rationale in class of compounds, e.g. xanthones cannot be indicated as a flavonoid but a xanthone.

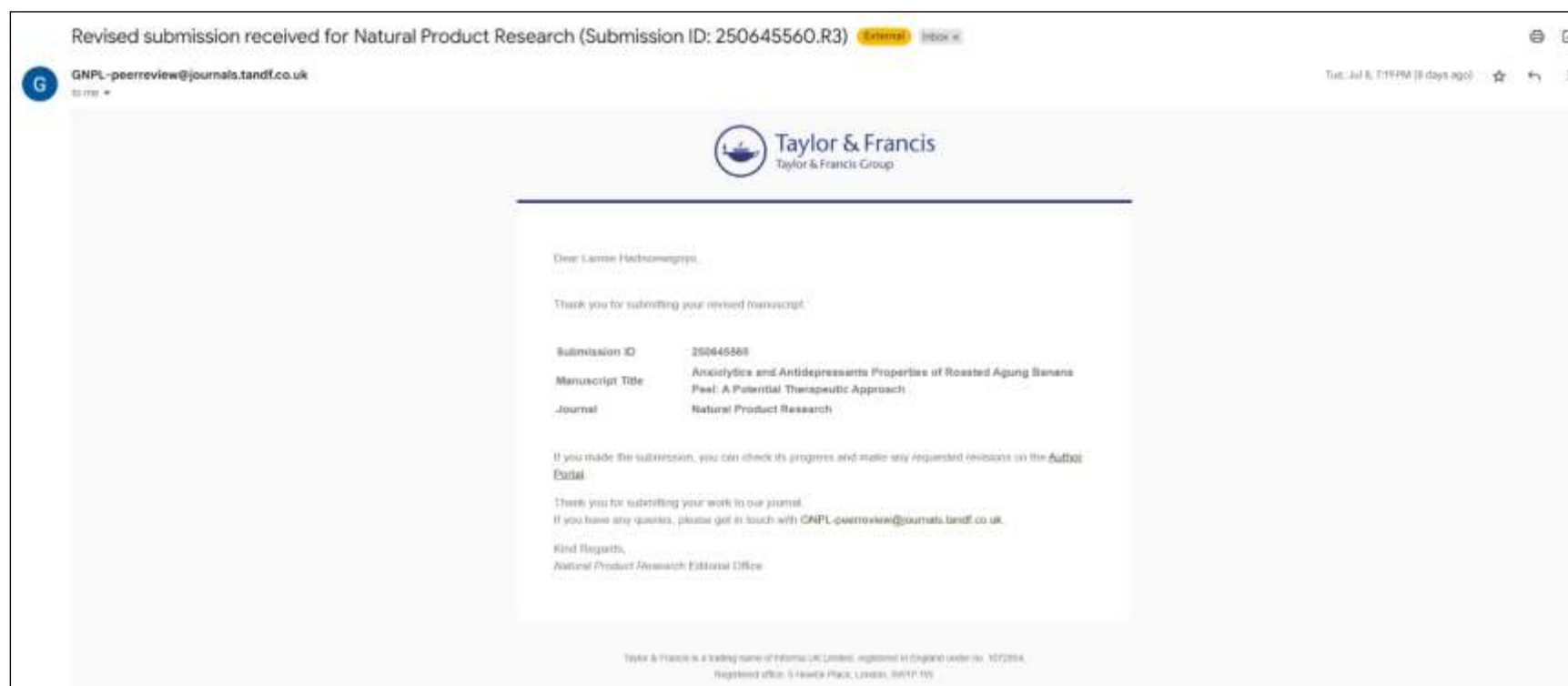
Alkaloids: Although they may have chemical characteristics compatible with the definition of alkaloids, amino acids, peptides, nucleosides, amino sugars and antibiotics are not considered alkaloids. (IUPAC – alkaloids (A01220), goldbook.iupac.org).

"7-Hydroxy-1-methoxy-2-methoxyxanthone" this form to report the chemical name is unusual: the two methoxy substituents should be indicated by the prefix "di". 7-Hydroxy-1,2-dimethoxyxanthone.

"Coumarin & Lignanoid"
Check the spelling. Maybe it should be "Lignanoid".

"2,4,5-Trihydroxybenzaldehyde" check the spelling.
