

ABSTRACT

This study examines the people who have a tendency to speak some foreign languages.

The writer collected the data by using a Walkman tape recorder as the audio recording and a list of questions. The data are gathered from the fourth subjects, using a list of questions that has been prepared by the writer. And then she clarifies the results and analyzed it by having observation at their social background. She also analyzed the data based on the parameters (setting, participant, relationship, topic and the function of interaction).
