

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter is divided into two main parts: conclusion and suggestions.

#### 5.1 Conclusion

Based on the analysis of figure of speech in selected Brad Paisley songs, it can be concluded that:

- 1) Figure of speech is the one aspect which is used in Brad Paisley songs to give the powerful effect and the meaning to the songs. After analysis the data, the writer found six types of figure of speech being used in Brad Paisley songs such as metaphor, hyperbole, simile, imagery, assonance, and irony.
- 2) Figure of speech is a language that uses words or expressions with a meaning that is different from literal meaning. One of the lyric that contained figure of speech is “she’s a yellow pair of running shoes, a holey pair of jeans”. The sentence is an example of metaphor because the he is comparing her to the very relaxing outfit-jean and running shoes. Also, yellow is a bright colour which is commonly used to show happiness. I think he means being with her makes him feel very happy and comfortable when she is around him.

3) In this study, the writer has 29 data. There are 4 data of metaphor, 7 data of hyperbole, 2 data of simile, 13 data of imagery, 1 data of assonance, 2 data of irony. It can be said that the dominant types of figure of speech in those songs is imagery. Imagery is language used by poets, novelists and other writers to create images in the mind of the reader. Imagery includes figurative and metaphorical language to improve the reader's experience through their senses.

## **5.2 Suggestions**

Based on the conclusions above, the writer would like to present some suggestion as follows:

- 1) This study is about the types of figure of speech in songs. The writer hopes that those who are interest in study figure of speech will keep analyzing the figure of speech because it can help people to understand the meaning that can be found in analyzing the song lyrics. - 2) The writer suggests that the next researcher can find other types of figure of speech which are not found in this study. Besides that, the next researchers can use other theories in conducting their study.
